How to Spot a Slide. A slide must be spotted correctly when entering it in a competition. The spot tells the projectionist the correct manner of projection for the slide. Please spot your slides in the following manner:

- 1. Holding the slide in your left hand, view the slide toward a light source as you would like it to show on the screen.
- 2. At the spot in the corner where your left thumb is holding the slide, place a spot large enough for the projectionist to see.
- 3. Make sure you have your name and title on the mount.

Promotion points in slides and print classes will be awarded as follows:

1st place 8 points 2nd place......... 6 points 3rd place........ 4 points 4th place......... 2 points HM.............. 1 point

No picture which has won 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th place shall be eligible for any future monthly contests. Any picture which has won any HONORABLE MENTION shall be eligible for 3 future contests.
