## **From the Annual Business Meeting**

**Dues** - The club voted to increase the individual dues to \$25, family membership is \$37.50, fulltime students will be 1/2 price at \$12.50.

**Digital contest** - It was voted that we will have an official digital contest starting in September. The details will be worked out by a Digital contest committee that will be made up of at least Chuck, Tim, Howard, Donna, Ernie, and Chip. Howard suggested that people have a choice of starting in the Novice or Unlimited class.

**Website** - Chip, Rogard and Patrick will be getting together over the summer to talk about enhancements to the website. Chip suggested that it would be possible to have folks enter their digital images in the digital contest via the website.

**Slide Contest** - will continue as long as there is interest.

**Categories for 2006-07 year** - We will have four categories next year - people, abstract, wildlife and landscape.
